## Mercury Adhesives



s modelers, one thing we are all familiar with is adhesives. When shopping for such glues and epoxies that are so integral to our hobby, we quickly realize just how many manufacturers there are that produce them. One such company is Mercury Adhesives and there are a couple of very strong points as to why you might want to consider their products for your next project ... or crash, as the case may be. They have been making and marketing various CA glues and epoxies for many years now, out of their headquarters in Canton, GA.

First, all Mercury products are designed and made in the USA, whether it's the specially concocted components inside the bottles or the labels themselves, they are 100% made of domestic materials. Second, Mercury uses a unique three-piece cap system on all of the bottles for their CA. What does that mean? It means you won't have to worry about your glue drying up before you get to use it, for one. Each lid also has a small pin that inserts into the tip of the applicator. This keeps the applicator from clogging with dried glue, which often leads to a thumb-tack covered in CA or a very

short tip with a huge orifice that has been cut down multiple times to relieve said clog. The CA glues are offered up in five different viscosities in addition to a Debonder and pump spray bottles of Accelerator.

Mercury Adhesives also sells their own line of epoxies, for all the high-strength applications where weight savings is not an issue. Served up in the traditional five, fifteen and thirty minute varieties, all of them are shock and water resistant. They can all also be used with filling agents such as micro balloons. New to

their lineup this year, Mercury just introduced their own thread-locking compound. It comes in a small, five gram bottle like most other thread-lockers and it is blue like most other thread-lockers, but there is one vital difference to their product. It has a micro brush in the cap! No more squeezing out tiny puddles into a soda-pop cap to be applied with a toothpick for this guy! The Mercury thread-locker is also temperature resistant up to 300 degrees, so you can even use them in some areas where other locking compounds are sure to fail.

Perhaps best of all throughout the entire Mercury Adhesives lineup, they are all 99.9 percent pure ... and no, I'm not just quoting a famous soap commercial. Other brands have been known to add "fillers" to their CA glues and epoxy. Not so with Mercury. That means you're getting all glue with each purchase and nothing else. The manufacturer also stands by their product like no other. They offer up an unconditional and unlimited guarantee on all of their newly purchased CA. If it's hardened up or doesn't work properly out of the bottle, send it in and you'll get a replacement pronto! Now that's service and a guarantee that you don't see too often in this day and age. O
